Clear Screen - Version 302 06. December 2012

Clear Screen (CLS) is a FreeWare tool from GreenHouse.

When executed, the user's 6530 type screen is cleared, the cursor is positioned to the first line of the first page, and the display mode is set to ASCII.

Starting with version 300, line 25 in the 6530 type screen is erased as well.

Command syntax:

- CLS erases the 6530 screen, positions the cursor to the top of the screen, and sets the display mode to ASCII.
- CLS x erases the 6520 screen as well as line 25, positions the cursor to the top of the screen and sets the display mode to ASCII. x is any character, e.g. CLS !
