${\tt NoACL}$  is a FreeWare tool from GreenHouse. It displays all disk files, lacking a relevant ACL.

## Command syntax:

NOACL[/OUT <file>/][-H] | <template>]

where

-H causes NOACL to display this screen.

<template> is a valid disk file name template.

Network names are NOT supported.

In case no <template> is supplied, the files from the users current location are evaluated.

e.g.

NOACL

NOACL \$GHS?.\*.EXEC\*
