PROGID is a FreeWare tool from GreenHouse.

It allows you to set the PROGID flag of a disk file without the need to be the owner of the file.

Command syntax is:

```
[run] PROIGID <disk-file> [OFF] | -H[ELP]
```

where:

<disk-file> is a fully qualified disk file name

OFF is a keyword; when present, the PROGID flag of

<disk-file> is removed.

-H[ELP] causes PROGID to display this screen.

PROGID is a SECOM supportive utility and should be controlled through a SECOM command.

The security settings should be:

Owner: sec.admin (= system security administrator)

Owner: sec.ad Security: "0000" Licensed: YES
