

SetRPW - Set Remote Password

By accident I needed a tool that would allow me to add remote passwords for not yet accessible systems. GUARDIAN as well as SAFECOM do not allow this.

So I developed the tool SETPW that does the trick.

Command syntax is:

```
[run] SETPW <user>[,]<sys-num>[,]<rpw> [,!]
```

where

user is any type of user, GUARDIAN as well as Alias user.
sys-num is the system number, for which a remote password has to be added.
rpw is the remote password (1 .. 8 characters).
! when present, causes an already existing remote password entry to be replaced.

Security Settings:

- owner should be SUPER.SUPER
- security should be "OOOO" or the SAFEGUARD equivalent

To successfully add/change an existing remote password, the user of this tool has to be SUPER.SUPER!
